3D-printed, lifelike blood vessel network created

Los Angeles (PTI): Scientists have successfully 3D printed lifelike, functional blood vessel network, an advance that could pave the way for artificial organs and regenerative therapies. The research, led by professor Shaochen Chen from the University of California San Diego in the US, addresses one of the biggest challenges in tissue engineering - creating lifelike tissues and organs with functioning networks of blood vessels that can transport blood, nutrients, waste and other biological materials. Researchers 3D printed a vasculature network that can safely integrate with the body's network to circulate blood. These blood vessels branch out into many series of smaller vessels, similar to the blood vessel structures found in body. The team developed an innovative bioprinting technology, using home-made 3D printers, to rapidly produce intricate 3D microstructures that mimic the sophisticated designs and functions of biological tissues. Researchers first created a 3D model of the biological structure on a computer. The computer then transferred 2D snapshots of the model to millions of microscopic-sized mirrors, which are each digitally controlled to project patterns of UV light in the form of these snapshots.

Bacteria, fungi improves soil bio-diversity of green roofs

Using living organisms such as bacteria or fungi, as an alternative to chemical fertilisers, can improve the soil biodiversity of green roofs, according to new research from the University of Portsmouth.

Green roofs are covered with plants and vegetation and are increasingly used in cities to make buildings more energy efficient and environmentally friendly. However, high winds, prolonged UV exposure and

unpredictable water availability mean that many green roofs lack nutrients, which can limit plant growth and the biodiversity of soil organisms, which are responsible for the quality of nutrients in the soil.

This could have implications for the environmental and economic benefits of green roofs.

The study, published in the journal Ecological Engineering, found that the addition of certain types of microbial inoculants (plant growth-promoting

bacteria and fungi used as an alternative to chemical fertilisers), in particular a fungi called Trichoderma, produced higher populations of tiny insects called springtails (which range from 0.25 to 6mm in size). While these changes improved the abundance of springtails, they did not result in a positive effect on plant growth.

Lead author Dr Heather Rumble, Senior Lecturer in Environmental Geography at the University of Portsmouth, said: "Few studies have investigated whether green roofs are a good urban habitat, particularly for soil organisms. We think that mature extensive green roofs have an established microbial community that may limit the success of commercial inoculants. The premise of our research was that as the soil food chain is lacking, we could try to boost it artificially. We wanted to identify the microbial inoculants that could improve biodiversity on green roofs that already exist and to better understand how healthy rooftop ecosystems sustain themselves."

In the field experiment, the researchers used an old green roof in Egham, outer London, and added living soil organisms including the fungi Trichoderma, mycorrhizal fungi and soil bacteria, which form the base of a food chain.



This robot can ask for clarification

New York (IANS): Researchers have developed an algorithm that lets robots ask for clarification when they are not sure what exactly a person wants them to fetch, especially when there are lots of very similar objects in close proximity to each other.

"Fetching objects is an important task that we want collaborative robots to be able to do," said lead researcher Stefanie Tellex, Professor at Brown University in Providence, Rhode Island, US.

"But it is easy for the robot to make errors, either by misunderstanding what we want, or by being in situations where commands are ambiguous. So what we wanted to do here was come up with a way for the robot to ask a question when it's not sure," Tellex said.

Tellex's lab had previously developed an algorithm that enables robots to receive speech commands as well as information from human gestures.

It is a form of interaction that people use all the time. When we ask

someone for an object, we'll often point to it at the same time.



Effective technique to prevent pest attacks

Giddalur: It is another example of the proverbial 'necessity is the mother of invention.' An idea successfully implemented by a farmer who was vexed with the continuous attacks of fruit flies and moths is now going to help hundreds of farmers from next year. Meet Dappili Venkatarami Reddy, a young farmer from Giddalur in Prakasam district who found a solution to save Pomegranate plantation from the juice sucking fruit flies and moths.

Maharashtra and Rajasthan are the leading Pomegranate producers and exporters in India with thousands of hectares of plantations while Andhra Pradesh is still growing it at a very less scale on around 2000 hectares. Though the atmosphere condition is reported to be suitable for Pomegranate, farmers have not taken it up because of two insects which are damaging the crop in the already grown plantations.

The Anar Butterfly or fruit borer or Deudorix Isocrates or Chilaka in local slang, creates maximum damage to the Pomegranate fruit in India. It lays eggs at the flowering or fruit setting stage and the larvae develop inside the fruits. They feed on the seeds and come outside by boring a hole through the fruit. Another insect, fruit fly or Dega Eega also damages the fruit by puncturing it and turning the seeds into black color. These two insects enter the Pomegranate crop at night and damage it in terms of quality and quantity and impact the returns for the farmer by more than 50 per cent. The horticulture department had suggested use of bags to cover individual fruit, which is practically not possible.

Prakasam district is known for its continuous drought conditions and suicides of farmers unable to repay the agriculture loans. As the conventional crops are not yielding much produce and support price, many farmers in the western area of the district started to grow sweet lime, a few years ago. After gaining experience and observing the market, few young farmers chose Pomegranate. Dappili Venkata Ramireddy from Giddalur, who has a



Pomegranate plantation at Singarpalli in Bestavaripet mandal is one of them.

Ramireddy planted Pomegranate on five acres about four years ago with an investment of Rs. 8 lakh. After his experience with the two insects in the first crop season, he got an idea to get rid of them completely. Ramireddy said, "We spent Rs. 8 lakh for the plantation to grow into trees. Last year we received the first crop and got return on the investment. But after understanding the damage level of the Dega Eega and Chilaka, we didn't want to lose a single fruit again. So, we completely covered the plantation with nylon net supported on wooden poles. This net prevented the bugs and also stopped birds and animals from entering the plantation. We spent about Rs. 50,000 per acre for the net and other material. This has proved to be effective and this year we have earned about Rs. 16 lakhs in return up to now."

The success story of Ramireddy spread to other Pomegranate farmers in the neighborhood and they also paid visits to his farm to

know more about it. They asked the Department of Horticulture to provide the subsidy for the net so that it would not become a financial burden to them. M Hari Prasad, assistant director of horticulture said, "Pomegranate is a sensitive crop. It should be protected from the bugs, birds and animals like monkeys. The idea implemented by Ramireddy has proved to be helpful to the farmers. We sent proposals to the government to provide these nets to all pomegranate farmers on subsidy so that they could also benefit using them. We are going to provide the nets to the farmers from the next season on 50 percent subsidy."

DRINKING BLUEBERRY JUICE MAY BOOST BRAIN FUNCTION

London (PTI): Drinking concentrated blueberry juice daily may improve brain function, especially in older people, a new study has claimed.

Blueberries are rich in flavonoids, which possess antioxidant and anti-inflammatory properties. "Our cognitive function tends to decline as we get older, but previous research has shown that cognitive function is better preserved in healthy older adults with a diet rich in plant-based foods," said Joanna Bowtell, from University of Exeter in the UK. The study excluded anyone who said they consumed more than five portions of fruit and vegetables per day, and all participants were told to stick to their normal diet throughout. Previous research has shown that risk of dementia is reduced by higher fruit and vegetable intake, and cognitive function is better preserved in healthy older adults with a diet rich in plant-based foods.

Optimum level of nitrogen fertiliser required to maintain soil carbon content

Newly published research from Iowa State University agronomists shows that the application of nitrogen fertilizer at optimum levels to corn and soybeans is required to maintain carbon in the soil, giving rise to a range of environmental and production benefits. In a study published on Wednesday in the peer-reviewed academy journal PLOS ONE, ISU agronomists showed nitrogen fertilizer can contribute to soil health and water quality by helping retain carbon.

"Our data show that nitrogen fertilizer, when applied at a level that maximizes crop production, is critical to maintain soil carbon for sustainable agricultural systems," said Michael Castellano, an associate

professor of agronomy and co-author of the study. "In fact, I'd say it plays an essential role."

The researchers collected soil samples from four ISU research farms in 1999 and 2000 and then again 15 years later, after each site received regimented applications of ni-

rogen fertilizer. The sites included both continuous corn and rotated corn-soybean production systems.

The results show nitrogen fertilizer helped build soil carbon content for the acres with only corn, while it was essential to maintain soil carbon content in the acres devoted to

a corn-soybean rotation. Insufficient nitrogen fertilizer in both systems led to soil carbon losses. Hanna Poffenbarger, a graduate assistant in agronomy and lead author of the paper, said nitrogen fertilization leads to increased crop yields, which leaves greater amounts of crop residue on the soil after harvest. The crop residue feeds soil microbes and builds carbon in the soil as it decomposes, Poffenbarger said. "Soil carbon content is positively associated with crop yield, and it's an important indicator of soil health," she said.

Soil carbon improves the ability of the soil to hold water, which reduces runoff and improves downstream water quality. Carbon also helps soil retain nutrients, including nitrates, Poffenbarger said.



Expert underlines need to nurture critical thinking

Hyderabad: Prof Jos Nolle, Dean of Seneca International, Toronto, has underlined the need of problem-based learning, instead of memorisation, to excel well in this year of globalisation. "Globalisation is equal to out of box. Memorisation doesn't train critical thinking, which is very crucial for our progress," Prof Jos said while delivering a lecture on "Leadership in the 21st century for Modern Applied Higher Education" in

Outlining the quality of a teacher, he said: "Teachers should have the technical experience while carrying passion about transferring knowledge and skills to others." He also opined that globalisation is not building walls. "Innovation is happening everywhere and we need each other to learn, solve, and grow," he said.

Earth's seven sisters only 40 lightyears away

An international team of scientists have discovered a set of seven near-earth-sized exoplanets circling a nearby star, named Trappist-1. They have reported this discovery recently in *Nature*. What is exciting about these exoplanets is that all of them may have water, with three falling in what is called the habitable zone. In the habitable zone, planets may have water in liquid form on their surface, and therefore the possibility of life. While this is not the same as finding life in the galaxy, discovering near earth-like planets with the possibility of water only 40 light years away does bring us closer to the discovery of extraterrestrial life.


The story of the star Trappist-1 is interesting on other counts as well. It was initially discovered by a team of Belgian scientists from Liege University, who used a relatively small and inexpensive telescope, only about 60 centimeters (or 2 feet) in diameter named Trappist. The star is named after the telescope. You can mount such a telescope in your garage! Compared to costs of giant telescopes such as the Hubble telescope, it is only a small fraction. Good science can still be done with much less money!

Trappist was installed in 2010, at La Silla, the European Southern Observatory, located at the edge of Atacama Desert in Chile, and one of the best places for viewing the night sky. This small telescope is fully automated, records the night sky on a camera, and is operated remotely from a control room in Liege, Belgium 12,000 kilometers away. The name Trappist (TRAnsiting Planets and Planetesimals Small Telescope) refers to a popular Belgian beer, and to remind the people that the telescope is Belgian.

The lead author of the *Nature* paper is Michael Gillon, a professor in University of Liege, Belgium, who had postulated that instead of searching for life only on exoplanets around sun-like stars, we could also search for exoplanets circling ultra-cool, red dwarf stars. Such stars are much more in number, and if they have earth-like planets, we are likely to find them much closer to us, making their study that much easier. There are 500 such red dwarfs within only 100 light-years of us, and therefore giving us a number of targets for such study. It also makes it possible to use much cheaper telescopes.

Gillon's intuition was startlingly fulfilled, when Trappist team observed what they thought were three earth-sized planets in a habitable zone around a star only 40 lightyears away. This is a very short distance by astronomical standards. They reported this discovery in May, 2016, immediately raising interest of the global astronomical community. Many others joined the hunt for habitable exoplanets around Trappist-1, including NASA with its Spitzer telescope. The joint exercise carried out by a number of teams and telescopes, determined that there were actually seven, and not three planets as originally thought that were circling Trappist-1. And all of them have the possibility of water, with three falling within the habitable zone.

The excitement is not just about finding habitable planets. It shows that we now have a much larger number of stars that may have earth-like planets

What are exoplanets?

Exoplanets are planets that are outside our familiar solar system. They circle other stars. These seven exoplanets belong to a star named as Trappist-1 that is only 40 lightyears from earth. We can study therefore them much more closely than others that are much further away. This, combined with the having the possibility of water and therefore life, has raised the excitement in the scientific community.

since Trappist-1 is so close, we can
study it more easily, using other more
sophisticated telescopes that are being
now launched. These telescopes can
not only detect the presence of water
vapour in the atmosphere, but also the
presence of oxygen, methane and
ozone - or bio-signatures - in the atmospheres
of these planets. While this
will not prove the existence of life
in the Trappist planets, they will make
this possibility greater.

While the red-dwarf is more fre-

quent than the sun-like stars, they are also weird. They are considerably smaller. Trappist-1 is only 8 % of the size of the sun and a little larger than Jupiter. This also means that the planets are much closer to their mother stars, and therefore have much smaller orbits and orbital periods. All the seven planets are bunched very close together, and complete their orbits - their year - within 1.5 to 20 days.

The smaller the orbit of these exoplanets, they come between us and the star - our line of sight to the star - much more frequently. This is what the astronomers call transit. A smaller

orbit, means a much higher number of transits in a given period, and therefore many more observations. As they travel between us and their star, they block the light from the star, and can be seen as a black dot moving across the star. The size of the dot and other measurements can generate a lot of information, apart from the simple of one determining their orbiting time. This how we now know the size, mass, time for orbiting of these seven exoplanets.

1 planets; or the conditions near a red dwarf star such as Trappist-1.

Trappist-1 is a young star -- only 500 billion years old -- unlike the sun, which is 4.5 billion years, or nine times its age. NASA says, "Such stars are extremely active in their early years -- shooting off potentially lethal flares and bursts of radiation" (Earth-sized planets). The newest, weirdest generation. Such radiation could potentially kill all life forms, or strip away all the oxygen from the planets, or lead to runaway greenhouse effect, leading to very high temperatures.

The optimists argue that we only know about life on earth. There may be completely different forms of life that can survive high radiation or

other dangers that would kill us. Without detailed knowledge, the scientific community is currently swinging from one extreme to the other. We just do not know enough to hazard a guess. Take the case of our solar system. From a distance, Venus, Earth and Mars are planets that all lie within the habitable zone. But have very different atmospheres. Unless we have more data from future studies, we can only imagine the possibilities.

While 40 lightyears is a short distance in astronomical terms, it is still far beyond the possibility of an interstellar mission. Using known technology, it would take us anything from 160,000 to 700,000 years to reach Trappist-1. Just to put it in perspective, 160,000 years is roughly the span of Homo sapiens - our species - on earth. So Star Trek alas, is still for TV, or the movie halls.

Despite the problems for life on Trappist-1, the interest is that these are by far the most interesting planets we have discovered till date. And they are at a distance that allows us to them closely in the coming years.

Let us remember that not only does the earth we know have an atmosphere, but we are altering this atmosphere in measurable ways that can be observed from other stars. If there is life on any of the Trappist planets, we can study its atmosphere for similar signs. This is our best hope of discovering life outside the solar system.

Researchers at the University of Virginia School of Medicine have reversed depression symptoms in mice by feeding them Lactobacillus, a probiotic bacteria found in live-cultures yogurt. Further, they have discovered a specific mechanism for how the bacteria affect mood, providing a direct link between the health of the gut microbiome and mental health.

Based on their findings, the researchers are optimistic that their discovery will hold true in people and are planning to confirm their findings in patients with depression. "The big hope for this kind of research is that we won't need to bother with complex drugs and side effects when we can just play with the microbiome," explained lead researcher Alban

Gaultier, PhD. "It would be magical just to change your diet, to change the bacteria you take, and fix your health – and your mood."

Depression is one of the most common mental health conditions in the United States, with up to 7 percent of people experiencing a major depressive episode, Gaultier noted. "It's a huge problem and the treatments are not very good, because they come with huge side effects," he said. The role of the gut microbiome – the bacteria that live inside us – has

searchers studying depression and other health conditions, both mental and physical. Gaultier, of the UVA Department of Neuroscience and its Center for Brain Immunology and Glia, set out to see if he could find a concrete link between depression and gut health. "When you're stressed, you increase your chance of being depressed,



and that's been known for a long, long time," he said. "So the question that we wanted to ask is, does the microbiome participate in depression?"

The answer appears to be yes. Looking at the composition of the gut microbiome before and after mice were subjected to stress, Gaultier's team found that the major change was the loss of Lactobacillus. With the loss of Lactobacillus came the onset of depression symptoms. Feeding the mice Lactobacillus with their food returned them to almost normal. "A single strain of Lactobacillus," Gaultier observed, "is able to influence mood." He and his team then went on to determine the mechanism by which Lactobacillus influences depression.

Cover cropping will enrich nutrients and prevent erosion

Orgetic farmers have to make hard choices between protecting soil from erosion and controlling weeds. For example, large-scale organic farming relies heavily on tillage. Tilling breaks up the soil to kill weeds and prepare for planting. But intense tillage can compact soil, cause erosion, and deplete nutrients. As a result, some organic farmers are turning to cover crops for weed control.

Cover crops are planted after harvest as an in-between crop. Cover crops improve the soil with living roots that protect it from erosion and add nutrients. Cover crops are usually plowed down, but another option is flattening the cover crop to form a thick carpet, or mat. They do this with a roller crimper—a heavy, rolling drum attached to a tractor.

The farmer then uses a no-till planter to plant seeds into the flattened mat for the next season. The new crop grows through the cover crop residue, which helps suppress weeds.

This method—called cover

crop-based organic rotational no-till—allows farmers to skip spring tillage and weeding. By simply flattening a cover crop, farmers don't have to disturb the soil for a new crop. The flattened cover crop suppresses weeds and retains soil moisture.

However, like many farming practices, this method has trade-offs. For example, if you flatten it too late, the cover crop might produce seeds. The result is a volunteer, or weedy, cover crop competing with next season's cash crop. And if you flatten the cover crop too early, it may regrow.

It's all in the timing, according to crop scientist Clair Keene. Keene is a researcher at The Pennsylvania State University. Keene and her colleagues wanted to find that perfect timing. So they planted an experiment in three different states: Delaware, Maryland, and Pennsylvania. For three years, they planted cover crops like hairy vetch-triticale and cereal rye, followed by cash crops like corn and soybeans.

The researchers flattened the

cover crops at different stages of growth to find the right combination. Was it possible to have a cover crop that was big enough to suppress weeds, but not too big that it produced seeds? They found that generally, letting the cover crop grow longer produces the best, if not perfect, results. "There's always trade-offs," said Keene. "A bigger cover crop is better at suppressing weeds as a mulch, but that comes with the cost of letting that crop grow longer, restricting the growing season for the corn or soybean."

Farmers want to plant their cash crop as early as possible, especially in northern states. If the cover crop is too small to be flattened, then they have to till it under, which defeats the purpose of improving soil quality. But if a cover crop reigns in a field for too long, it might start to produce seeds. Every cover crop is a little different. For instance, the group found that cereal rye needs to be rolled in the middle of grain fill so that it doesn't produce seed and show up when it isn't wanted.



Caffeine prevents lung damage caused by oxygen therapy

A new study finds that caffeine may protect the lungs from damage caused by prolonged oxygen therapy, such as oxygen supplementation given to premature babies. The article is the first of its kind to study the positive effects of caffeine on the lungs' minute tissue structures. It is published in the American Journal of Physiology—Lung Cellular and Molecular Physiology.

Long-term oxygen therapy increases oxidative stress in the endoplasmic reticulum (ER), a network of membranes involved in protein building. The increase in ER stress leads to inflammation and problems with the formation of too few blood vessels and air sacs in the lungs. Researchers from the Medical College of Wisconsin studied two groups of rat pups that were exposed to more than 90 percent oxygen to simulate the type of oxygen therapy commonly used with premature newborns. One group was treated with caffeine injections ("caffeine"), and one was not ("high-oxygen"). The two groups were compared to a control group of pups that were exposed to normal room air only.

The number of blood vessels present in the lungs of the high-oxygen group was significantly lower than that of the control and caffeine groups. "Caffeine improved the blood vessel count in the [high-oxygen]-exposed group," wrote the research team. They also found more new air sacs and less inflammation and markers of oxidative stress in the rat pups treated with caffeine. "The [stress] responses were all attenuated by caffeine." The researchers also found that the ER in the cells lining the blood vessels in the lungs was wider than usual in the high-oxygen group.







SCIENTISTS UNRAVEL THERAPEUTIC TARGET FOR DIABETES-RELATED BLINDNESS

Specific cells in the retina trigger inflammation and vision impairment associated with diabetes, according to new research out of Case Western Reserve University School of Medicine. The findings unexpectedly implicate Muller cells—which provide structural support in the retina—as key drivers of the process. Researchers now have a therapeutic target in hand and understand initial steps of diabetic retinopathy, one of the most common and debilitating side effects of diabetes. Carlos Subauste, Associate Professor of Medicine and Pathology and

Timothy Kern, PhD, Professor of Medicine, Ophthalmology and Pharmacology at Case Western Reserve University School of Medicine led the research, recently published in *Diabetes*. Said Subauste, "Our studies uncovered a novel mechanism that explains the development of experimental diabetic retinopathy. Diabetic retinopathy is the leading cause of visual impairment in working age



adults in the western world."

In the study, Subauste and his team zeroed in on a receptor protein that sits on the surface of Muller cells. They discovered the receptor, CD40, sends signals to nearby cells called microglia and macrophages to initiate harmful inflammation in the retina. But, CD40 is a regular on the surfaces of many cells, so Subauste and his team had to

devise a clever strategy to determine which cells initiate the harmful chain of events. "From studies done with Dr. Kern, we knew mice with no CD40 are protected from diabetic retinopathy," said Subauste. "We created transgenic mice that only express CD40 on Muller cells to further examine the role of the receptor." The researchers discovered that mice with the receptor


limited to Muller cells still developed retinopathy. A closer look revealed that CD40 also elicits pro-inflammatory molecules from bystander microglia and macrophages. The researchers found that CD40 makes Muller cells secrete a small energy molecule called ATP. In turn, ATP engages a specific receptor on the surface of microglia and macrophages triggering inflammatory responses in these cells. The researchers had found their culprit. Their study provides direct evidence that a single receptor on the surface of Muller cells is sufficient to cause harmful inflammation that leads to experimental diabetic retinopathy.

Said Subauste, "Our study identifies CD40 as a therapeutic target against diabetic retinopathy." The prevalence of the receptor throughout the body suggests the findings may also be applicable to inflammatory bowel disease, atherosclerosis, or lupus. "Add-back of CD40 represents an elegant means of testing the hypothesis," said

a commentary in the journal featuring the study, calling the findings "unprecedented." Diabetic retinopathy is a major complication of diabetes that impairs the ability of the retina to sense light. For years, scientists have implicated inflammation as a primary driver of the complication, but it has been difficult to tease apart the many cells and signal molecules involved.



Medak SP G Chandana Deepti speaks about the need to recognise talents of women, safety measures taken by district police and bad parenting on International Women's Day. Excerpts:

What is your message to women on the occasion of International Women's Day-2017?

Women should recognise their talents and with whatever resources available with them, with confidence, they need to seek help from others when necessary in order to achieve their goals. Discrimination against women is still there, but with self-confidence and hard work, it can be overcome. Girls/women should take challenges positively and use whatever information they have at their disposal to create awareness among uneducated girls/women.

It's been four months since districts have been reorganised. Are the women feeling any safer now than they used to be before?

One of the achievements of the Medak police in terms of protecting young girls and women is reducing sexual ha-

rassment in public places. Thanks to our SHE Teams, girls don't have anything to be worried now.

What are the activities the department has been undertaking to protect girls/women in Medak district?

Girls/women can use WhatsApp to communicate directly with us now. We are also going to start a website soon with live chat between the police and the public every day. We are also launching 'Dial-your-SP' once a week in addition to Prajavani grievance day every week on Monday.

We are also going to put grievance boxes in bus stands, police stations and other public places. Not only victims, but also friends, neighbours or relatives who may see a girl/woman in

distress can lodge their grievances in those boxes. We will keep their identity anonymous.

We are also doing community policing by interacting with people in villages using our Village Police Officers. We are also offering first counselling to girls/women in distress. We are also going to implement 33 per cent reservation for women in police department.

We have been conducting six activities every day to empower and protect girls/women. We are also holding demonstrations, pasting posters on social evils/issues, conducting sports meets and job festivals. In fact, we have been taking an active part in making villages Open Defecation-free (ODF).

Is CHETANA campaign which was started by former SP of United Medak B Sumathi is being continued?

In every police circle, the campaign to address family issues through counselling is being carried out. Availability of professional psychologists at mandal-level is a problem. But the programme will be continued. Bad parenting is also a challenge affecting children in rural areas. Alcoholic parents make weak-minded children.
